
SCHOLARSHIP FOR GRADUATING SENIORS

THE SACRAMENT OF HOLY BAPTISM

PRESENTATION

Pastor Dawn: God, who is rich in mercy and love, gives us a new birth into a living hope through the sacrament of baptism. By water and the Word God delivers us from sin and death and raises us to new life in Jesus Christ.
