Dear brothers and sisters in Christ Jesus,

Lent is a 40-day season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving that begins on Ash Wednesday and ends at sundown on Holy Thursday. It's a period of preparation to celebrate the Lord's resurrection at Easter.

Like most people, I enjoy celebrating Easter. However, I have been considering it a distant second to Christmas. As I thought about that, it bothered me that I enjoyed Christmas more than Easter.

At Christmas, there are presents and fun traditions, and lots of good treats and food. it's all about God sending His Son. But think about Easter...that's about me, my sins and guilt, angry mobs against Jesus, a brutal crucifixion, and then the empty tomb.

When we look at Easter, we need to embrace the true meaning of it. If Christ wasn't willing to go to the cross, I would still be dead in my sins. If not for his resurrection, I'd have no hope of eternal life.

This is the very reason for observing Lent...to come before the Lord and prepare out hearts for renewal. It's a way of identifying with Christ, who endured the cross for the joy that was set before Him, according to Hebrews 12:2

We need to learn to focus on Jesus' passion during Lent and the time prior to Easter Sunday. When we do, we can truly proclaim "He is Risen!" He is risen indeed!"


