Happy Spring! The warm temperatures of this past weekend give us a glimpse of the coming weeks ahead. Spring is not just warmer weather and longer days, it is also a time of renewal and growth. At St. Paul's, we will be looking to do the same. With the departure of Pastor Morris, we will betaking the next few months to do a self-evaluation as we plan how to move forward.

On Palm Sunday, the church council had the opportunity to meet with Reverend Dione Stepanek, the Assistant to the Bishop and the Director of Evangelical Mission for the La Crosse Area Synod. It was a very informative conversation, including these highlights:

There is a shortage of pastors. There are more than 10 open positions in the La Crosse Area Synod. Similar shortages are seen throughout the ELCA.

Pastors willing to serve in a part-time capacity are not readily available.

If we want to look at partnering with another congregation, the Synod Rev. Dione Stepanek will help facilitate that.

Many smaller congregations are using a transition team to selfevaluate prior to entering the call process. Rev. Dione Stepanek

Our congregation's location, size and financial position offer St. Paul's some unique challenges and opportunities. After our conversation with Rev Ste-


panek, the council decided to move forward with a transition team – a committee of five or six individuals – to engage congregation members, the Synod, and outside entities to explore the future direction of the congregation. The committee will explore a wide range of options, which may include but not limited to: maintain the status quo, returning to a full-time pastor, partnering with another congregation (ELCA or a denomination in full communion with the ELCA), merging with another congregation and even preparing to close our doors. Findings will be brought to the council and congregation to help determine our next steps.

During this process, we would greatly appreciate your help. Some of you will be asked to serve on the transition committee and I hope that you prayerfully consider and accept the call. Everyone will be asked to provide input through surveys/questionnaires.

As we move forward together, thank you for your continued support of St. Paul's. Please let me know if you have any questions or comments.
